



Children's Discovery Center's Exclusion Of Illness

Condition	Symptoms	Exclusion Policy
Cold	Mild, no temperature, feeling okay. No other symptoms and discharge is clear.	Child may attend.
Fever	(A warning that is not right with the body) Child has a fever of 100 degrees or higher after adding a degree under the arm.	Child needs to stay home for 24 hours after fever goes down to 98.6 degrees without medicine.
Sinus Infection	Greenish discharge from nose (Might be a sign of infection.)	Child needs to stay home until gone or return with approval from doctor.
Coughing	Chronic cough, deep, or hacking (Might be a sign of infection.)	Child needs to stay home until gone or return with approval from doctor.
Coughing	Mild cough.	Child may attend.
Sore Throat	Mild sore throat	Child may attend.
Sore Throat	Appearance of swollen tonsils or glands, white spots in throat, hurts when swallows and/or complains of not feeling well.	You may need to seek advice from your doctor. Child needs to stay home until gone or return with approval from doctor.
Rash	Not contagious.	Child may attend.
Rash	Unable to determine kind or cause of rash.	Child needs to stay home until gone or return with doctor approval.
Stomachache	Light stomachache, absolutely no diarrhea, vomiting or temp.	Child may attend.
Stomachache	Vomiting or severe cramping.	Child needs to stay home for 24 hours after last episode.
Diarrhea	Three consecutive really loose stools or hard cramping.	Child needs to stay home for 24 hours after last episode.
Conjunctivitis (pink eye)	Redness or discharge from one or both eyes. (VERY Contagious.)	Child needs to be on medication for 48 hours and have a doctor's release form before returning to school.
Ear Infection	Complains of ear hurting or pulls at ear often and may have a fever.	Child may need medication and needs to have a normal temperature with no pain before returning or return with approval from your doctor.
Head Lice	Nits (lice eggs) or lice insects are detected in hair. (If at CDC you will be required to pick up your child immediately!)	Child may return after he/she has been treated with medicated shampoo and ALL NITS ARE REMOVED. (A vinegar and water rinse will soften the nits so you can comb them out.)
Allergies	Runny nose and slight congestion.	Child may attend.
Flu	Vomiting and fever, ect.	Child must stay home for 24 hours after last symptom.
Vomiting	Mild, only vomited once within a 24 hour period.	Child may attend.
Vomiting	Chronic, vomited more than once within 24 hour period.	Child must stay home from 24 hours after he/she vomits for the last time.
